

# **Admission Procedure**

The school has a compact system for admission. A student who is willing to seek admission in the school has to register his/her name on registration form. The registration form is to be submitted in the office of the school. Admission test is organized by the school. If the student is successful in the test and other criteria decided by the admission committee, his/her name is sent to the principal to grant the admission.

The school reserves the right to admission. In all admission cases the decision of the principal is final. The admission is confirmed only after the school fee is deposited & B.P.L. admission will be given as per govt. rules.

## **CURRICULUM**

The Pacific International Public School is affiliated with C.B.S.E. and adopted the syllabus and guide lines given by N.C.E.R.T. The medium of instructions is English. The teaching is intensive and in a wider spectrum, giving fullest exposure for deeper knowledge and understanding with inquisitiveness for advancement. Training on computer has also been introduced from primary level.

The school has separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Computer. Each laboratory is well equipped with all the required instruments and apparatus. All the modern tools and techniques of education have been employed and training is also imported side by side to promote interest in hobbies, games, music, art and crafts. Besides, this every conceivable co-curricular activity will form an integral part of the curriculum.

## **SPORTS**

The PIPS School is dotted with 4 full-fledged playing fields spread across its over 2.25 acre campus. The school provides a matrix of intra and inter-school sports activities. In the Junior Section, depending upon the season, all boys undergo training in Hockey, Football, Cricket, Athletics, Basketball and Table Tennis. The students are encouraged to specialize in a sport, according to their inclination and also based on the suggestions of the expert Coaches. However, the boys are encouraged to play inter-house tournaments and participate in other sports, to promote all-rounder sportsmen. This emphasis also instills team spirit skills for life beyond the school days, and a wider appreciation of sport in general. Traditional Indian games such as Kho-kho, Kabaddi, Carrom, Chess are celebrated at the annual sports meet.



## ***PARENTS AND SCHOOL***

Parents wishing to discuss the progress of their children with the teaching staff may visit the school only 3rd and 4th Saturday of the month between 11:00 AM to 01:00 PM, However for any urgent purpose, they may meet the principal and/or the management in the day at any time.

Parents are advised to go through the student's diary every day for any message, notice and report. Parents are expected to ensure proper observance of the school discipline by their wards and see to it that their children are regular and punctual and come to school neat and clean dress in the prescribed uniform. Suggestions made by parents in a cooperative and constructive spirit would be most welcome and appreciated.

The library at PIPS is adequately equipped with all kinds of literature, reading, material of interest, course books, comics, life histories of freedom fighters patriots, prophets and inadequate volumes of reference books etc.
